### Member Contact Information:

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a relationship between farmers and members. Rather than simply purchasing food, members receive a portion of the farm's harvest. We - Blue Rooster Farms - wish to provide you - the Member - with fresh, local, seasonal food. You wish to receive a portion of our harvest.

This agreement outlines our shared commitments to that relationship.

1. Our Egg Shares run quarterly (January through March; April through June; July through September; and October through December) throughout the year. Although you can receive your eggs throughout the week, for billing purposes we count Friday as the day you receive them to keep our records straight. The number of deliveries you receive depends on where Friday falls on the calendar during the quarter. Eggs are delivered either every 2 weeks, every 3 weeks, or once a month. You will receive 1 dozen large to x-large eggs on your week or 18 small to medium eggs which are usually more than the equivalent weight to a dozen large eggs.
2. By joining our CSA, you are agreeing to share in the risk and rewards of farming with us and other members. We have learned over our years of raising chickens that they are a very fickle animal which require little to no variances in their routine in order to consistently lay eggs. This is in direct opposition of the natural environment in which they live. Chicken eggs change in their size and numbers (or they stop laying altogether) for a variety of issues: too hot, too cold, too rainy, predator stresses, etc. In the likely event that we cannot delivery your full egg share we will notify you about the amount of eggs to expect. If we have to stop delivering altogether for more than one dozen eggs, we will compensate you by giving you a credit on future goods we offer.
3. Deliveries will be made throughout the week. We will work with you if you cannot receive a delivery one week, i.e., vacation. We require 3 days notice for any weeks you are not available to receive a share.
4. Chickens are fed and forage outside for bugs and grubs. They also eat leftovers from the garden. They are kept in a large, enclosed fenced area for predator protections. They are considered cage free and free range.
5. We take the safety of our food seriously. Eggs naturally have a protective layer on them and are cleaned only if necessary to remove nesting box liter. All eggs should be cooked before consuming.
6. The best way to communicate with us is by text or email. You may text us at (205)222-0211. Our email is [csa@blueroosterfarms.com](mailto:csa@blueroosterfarms.com). We will do our best to respond as soon as possible, but please understand that we spend most of our time in the field. We will communicate with you primarily by email for weekly updates. Please contact us with any news of the following: changes to your postal or email address, problems with delivery, or dissatisfaction with your share. When you sign up, you will be added to our distribution list. Please read any email from us. We depend on being able to communicate information such as what produce you will be receiving that week, recipe ideas, or other farm happenings.
7. We appreciate your commitment to us. Your share fees provide us with money to purchase feed and equipment. Egg Share prices vary and are dependent on which share you pick (2 or 3 or 4 weeks) and where it fits into the previous share's schedule. Once we know your preference we will let you know pricing. In general eggs are \$5 a dozen. Additionally, a \$5.00 once a quarter fee will be added to all egg shares to help with packaging and delivery
8. You agree to purchase a quarterly share of eggs that will continue until you tell us otherwise. You understand that, although unlikely, the farm may change parts of this agreement related to production and distribution from time to time. You understand that they will contact you via email in advance of any changes to this agreement.
9. By replying to the email with your name, address, and phone number, you have read and agree with these terms.
